


FOUR TO SIX MONTHS

- Finalize guest list
- Order wedding invitations and announcements
- Determine reception menu
- Select wedding-day transportation
- Shop for wedding bands
- Help mothers select and coordinate their dresses
- Shop for bridal accessories (headpiece/veil, lingerie, shoes, jewelry, going away outfit)
- Shop for bridesmaids' accessories (jewelry, shoes, purses)
- Order wedding cake and groom's cake




TWO MONTHS

- Mail / email invitations
- Develop a system for organizing RSVPs
- Attend dress fittings/alterations
- Confirm with bridesmaids that they have purchased lingerie and shoes, and have scheduled/attended their dress fitting
- Schedule wedding day hair and makeup preview/trial
- Arrange rehearsal and dinner plans
- Schedule final beauty/grooming appointments for the week of wedding haircut and/or colour, manicure/pedicure, massage, tanning, waxing
- Complete proper documents for changing your name
- Prep for bachelor and bachelorette parties




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ONE MONTH

- Obtain marriage license
- Finalize itinerary with vendors and ceremony/reception locations
- Begin making seating plan for reception dinner
- Pick up wedding bands
- Schedule final gown fittings and date to pick up finished and pressed wedding gown.
- Call guests who have not responded to invitation
- Start on/complete thank you notes for any wedding gifts already received
- Break in your wedding shoes
- Arrange lodging for out-of-town guests
- Arrange brunch for out-of-town guests morning after wedding before they leave as thanks for coming
- Decide on receiving line – where & who



ONE WEEK

- Pick up gown - try it on at the dressmaker's for final fit, and do not try it on again at home
- Host bridesmaids' party
- Attend final grooming/beauty appointments
- Call/email venues and all vendors to finalize arrangements, delivery times, and any other details
- Prepare tip envelopes and arrange for someone to distribute them the day of
- Finalize packing for honeymoon
- Confirm travel arrangements; if travelling abroad, purchase small amount of local currency
- Confirm transportation details
- Review timetables and details with vendors



TWO WEEKS

- Confirm final guest count to caterer/reception location
- Confirm rehearsal dinner guest count
- Begin packing for honeymoon
- Break in wedding shoes at home scuff the bottom, walk around in them
- Begin to make final payments to vendors (payments due from this point up to wedding day)
- Finalize seating plan
- Prepare an "emergency kit" for wedding-day mishaps
- Meet with photographer and videographer; submit list of must-take shots



TWO TO THREE DAYS

- Drop off wedding accessories at venue or deliver to wedding planner
- Pack a bag for the wedding day
- Pick up tuxedos for groom, groomsmen, and fathers. Try on tuxedos - confirm all articles of clothing and accessories have been supplied
- Cut cheques for remaining vendor payments



ONE DAY TO GO

- Attend ceremony rehearsal
- Distribute the wedding-day itinerary to all parents, attendants, and other involved parties
- Hand over remaining accessories to wedding planner, church coordinator, or other organizer
- Attend rehearsal dinner
- Present attendants with their gifts at the rehearsal dinner
- Go to bed early so you will be well rested for the amazing day that lies ahead of you



THE WEDDING DAY

- Eat breakfast
- Arrange to get checked in and have luggage delivered to your hotel
- Give vendor payments to planner or best man for distribution
- Get beautiful
- Get dressed
- Switch your engagement ring to your right hand
- Marry your love and have a great day!

staying WITHIN YOUR BUDGET



The average couple spends somewhere around \$28,000 on their wedding – even before factoring in the engagement ring or honeymoon.


Whether you're planning an intimate wedding or a more lavish affair, one of your first steps in planning your wedding should be to set up-and stick to a basic budget. Budgeting is easiest if you have clear priorities. When you've decided on your must haves, cutting the costs becomes a snap. Though your families may elect to help you out, they are in no way obligated to do so.

To keep from breaking the bank (after all, who wants to start a marriage tens of thousands of dollars in debt?), make sure you and your partner agree on your priorities before committing to anything. Building in a 5 percent cushion just in case will also save your sanity when the actual costs inevitably come in a little higher than expected.

the venue

- Are tables and chairs included in the rental fee? Linens? What is included? What rentals will I need?
- How early can you get in the building to decorate? Are there decorating restrictions?
- How early can the caterer arrive?
- Do they have a list of approved caterers?
- Is security required?
- What are the alcohol policies?
- Who is responsible for cleanup? When must the hall be cleaned?
- Can the facility cancel the date? If so, with what kind of notice?
- What are the payment options and arrangements?
- What are the setup policies?
- Is parking available? Is it paid or free?
- Does the facility require insurance? Who is responsible for providing it?
- Dance floor/music allowed? Where do musicians set up?
- What hours do I have the facility? Is anything else going on during the same day?
- Are there any other restrictions?
- Are there any renovations or remodels happening before our event date?
- How many hours are included in the rental agreement?

initial consultation

WHAT TO BRING/KNOW:

- Your vision for the ceremony & reception
- Number of guests
- Tentative wedding date
- Ideas and pictures
- Decision makers that need to be included in tour



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
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what to ask:

WHAT IS THE FACILITY'S CAPACITY? It should comfortably accommodate the number of guests you expect to attend.

IS THERE A ROOM AVAILABLE FOR THE BRIDE TO USE? If you want to get ready at the facility instead of the salon or at home, make sure there is a sizeable, well lit place to do so.

WILL YOU SCHEDULE MORE THAN ONE WEDDING FOR OUR DATE? If so, you want to ensure they will give your wedding the proper care and attention it deserves.

ARE THERE RESTRICTIONS ON WHAT WE CAN DO TO DECORATE? Sometimes facilities have restrictions on the use of candles and other decorations. Most commonly there are restrictions on what can be used for the send-off.

ARE YOU PLANNING ON ANY REMODELS OR RENOVATIONS BEFORE OUR WEDDING? You don't want to plan for one colour scheme and find the carpet and walls are completely different than you expected.

WHAT IS THE RENTAL FEE? Find out what is included, how much the deposit is, and when the balance is due.

HOW MANY HOURS ARE INCLUDED IN THE RENTAL AGREEMENT? Sometimes there are a set number of hours and facilities will charge for each additional hour.

WHERE SHOULD THE MUSICIANS SET UP? Make sure the space properly accommodates your musicians and that they have access to electricity. Also verify that the dance floor is large enough to accommodate your number of guests.

IS THERE A WEDDING COORDINATOR ON STAFF THAT WILL BE THERE THE ENTIRE TIME? You will want the person you have been dealing with to be there the whole time to make things run smoothly.

WHO IS IN CONTROL OF THE SOUND SYSTEM? Find out if your facility has someone to man the sound booth or if you need to provide your own professional.

HOW IS ACCESSIBILITY & PARKING? Check out the parking situation to make sure they have enough for your size event and that it is conveniently available. Also make sure the facility is handicap accessible if necessary.



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

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OUT-OF-TOWN guests



When planning your special day, take a few minutes to think about those special people in your life who will travel from far away to be with you on your wedding day. You will want to make their stay an enjoyable, as well as memorable, experience.

Most out-of-town guests prefer not to impose on those involved in the hectic wedding schedule. Make this easy for them by negotiating a group rate with a local hotel. If you are holding your reception in a hotel, that may be the first stop to make when looking for rooms for your guests. Most hotels give discounts for groups of seven or more guest rooms.


First, let the hotel know approximately how many rooms your guests will need. Then, send an E-mail to your out-of-town guests with the hotel's special room rate and reservation number so that guests can arrange their own reservations. Please be sure to inform your guests that they need to contact the hotel at least two weeks prior to the wedding. By doing so, any rooms that are not booked can be released and you will not be held accountable for them.

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

photography

Long after your wedding day is over, your photos will provide lasting memories.

Be sure your photographer knows about any meaningful details you've planned! Work with your photographer/videographer to create a meaningful representation of your entire day and to capture all the elements you hope to preserve. You not only need to find a photographer that you feel comfortable with but you also need to know what photo options are available and what shots should not be missed. **No other vendor will have as lasting role in your wedding as your wedding photographer.**

initial consultation

WHAT TO BRING/KNOW:

- Tentative timeline of your day
- General idea of budget
- Style of photography you like
- How interactive you want your photographer to be (actively posing people or unobtrusively documenting)
- End products you are interested in (album, portraits, book, digital files, etc.)

- Can we look at your sample albums, guest books, online galleries, etc?
- When do I get the digital files?
- Will I have rights to the digital files?
- How many weddings have you photographed?

Make your reception celebration a reflection of your interests, personality and style, and show your guests a great time while you're at it.

Think of the reception tables as your canvas. You can create any mood you want if you choose your 'paint' wisely. Considering serving just one or two signature cocktails along with wine and beer. Search for a recipe that works with your wedding's tone.

Cutting the cake is a highlight of the reception. If you've chosen cupcakes or a nontraditional dessert, most bakers will provide a small, special cake for the traditional first cut.

WHAT TO BRING/KNOW:

- Wedding date
- Venue location
- Number of guests on your invite list
- Timeline of the day
- Recipes you want included
- Need for special meals (kids menu, vegan, gluten-free, allergies, etc.)
- Tipping Policy



what to ask

- Will you schedule more events for our date?
- Do you charge for extra services (cake cutting, bar service, etc.)?
- What equipment is included?
- How many staff will be there?
- What are payment terms?
- Do you feed the DJ, photographer, band or do I need to include them in the count?
- Who cleans up the room afterwards?
- Is travel to my venue location included?
- What is included in the price?
- Will there be a coffee station or pot of coffee on the table? Will there be ice water?
- Will the person I've been working with be at our wedding?

BRIDAL gowns



what to ask:

AM I BUYING A CUSTOM FIT?

You are not shopping for just a dress, but a fit as well. Choose a shop that will make sure you look stunning in a perfectly fitted gown.

WHEN DO THEY ORDER THE DRESS?

Some shops may take the order but wait to put it through until closer to your wedding day. Make sure your gown will be ordered with plenty of time to spare.

IS THERE AN IN-HOUSE SEAMSTRESS?

Find out if the shop does their own alterations or if they hire out the service.

HOW WILL THE DRESS LOOK WHEN PICKED UP?

Find out if the gown will be steamed or pressed, whether the shop takes steps to preserve the gown's shape, and whether the dress bag will be roomy enough to prevent crushing.

initial consultation

WHAT TO BRING/KNOW:

- Idea of budget
- Wedding date
- Wedding location (indoor, outdoor, church, barn, etc.)
- Wedding style (formal, casual, vintage, elegant, etc.)
- Number of bridesmaids
- Idea of colours

If your bridesmaids come in many shapes and wear all different sizes, consider picking the color and fabric for the dresses and allow them to choose their own style.

If un-identical dresses is not something you want, consider dresses in an A-line style which is flattering to all body types and sizes. You could also consider having your bridesmaids wear wraps to fit their body types.



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

BRIDAL BOUTIQUE

traditional FORMAL WEAR

questions to ask

When it comes to weddings almost anything goes. Whether you purchase or rent your tuxedos or suit make sure it complements your fiancée's and wedding party's style. Traditionally the best man, groomsmen and attendants pay for their own formal wear.

Most formal wear rental stores do offer package deals for the entire bridal party, saving everyone money.



WHEN SHOULD WE ORDER TUXEDOS FOR OUR WEDDING? at least 3-4 months prior to the wedding is recommended

WHO SHOULD WEAR TUXEDOS?

traditionally the groom, groomsmen, ushers, fathers, and ring bearer will all be in tuxedos.

WHEN IS THE FINAL FITTING? usually a day or two before the wedding so any needed adjustments can be taken care of before the wedding.

WHEN DO THE MEN HAVE TO BE MEASURED FOR THEIR TUXEDOS? suit measurements should be in no later than 4-6 weeks prior to the wedding.

WHAT ABOUT OUT-OF-TOWN GROOMSMEN? suits should be ordered in the city where the wedding is taking place and members of the wedding party living out of town should be professionally measured at their local formalwear or menswear store. The measurements can be called in, sent in, or submitted online so that the suits/tuxedos will be ready for the final fitting when your groomsmen come to town for the wedding.

IS AN APPOINTMENT NECESSARY? it's a good idea to call ahead and schedule an appointment.

- Do you have recordings I can listen to?
- How many years of experience do you have?
- Can we make special requests? How many?
- Will you provide a sound system?



what to bring/know:

WEDDING DAY LOCATIONS

Know your ceremony site, reception facility, photo shoot areas, getting ready locations, and after party spots so you can determine where you may need transportation.

ESTIMATED TIME FRAME

How long it will take for pictures after the ceremony, a receiving line, and what time you need to be at the reception?

TOTAL NUMBER OF PASSENGERS

Will it be just the married couple or the entire bridal party? Will you include the photographer, personal assistant, etc?



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Transportation for the married couple, wedding party, and families is an important factor on the wedding day.

cost breakdown

\$ NUMBER OF PASSENGERS

The more passengers you have, the larger the vehicle you need.

\$ HOURS OF USE

Many services specify a minimum number of hours the vehicle must be hired. Make sure to budget extra time or there may be overtime fees.

\$ FUEL

Though fuel is generally included in the hourly rate, there may be a fuel surcharge for greater distances.

\$ TIME OF YEAR

Prices are higher during peak times of the year such as wedding season, prom or homecoming season, and graduation.

\$ DAY OF THE WEEK

Limos are generally in higher demand on the weekend, so are priced accordingly.



questions to ask



FOR outdoor EVENTS

DOES THE SITE HAVE ANY SPECIFIC RESTRICTIONS?

Make sure to find out well in advance which rules and regulations apply to your event.

IS THERE RESTROOM ACCESS?

Even if there is accessibility, the restrooms may not be suitable for your affair. Portable restrooms now come equipped with the latest amenities.

DO WE NEED POWER? IS POWER PROVIDED?

If you're setting up lighting, a sound system, or have live music, you may need to set up a generator in order to have access to electricity.

WHAT RENTALS WILL I NEED?

Does the facility provide necessities such as chairs, sound system, awnings, tents, restrooms, etc., or will you need to rent your own?

WHAT WILL THE SITE LOOK LIKE WHEN WE GET MARRIED?

The appearance of outdoor sites can change dramatically with the season.

IS THERE AN ALTERNATE OPTION IN CASE OF INCLEMENT WEATHER?


